PREPARE: Print the downloadable *Live-Love-Leave* sheet

CLUES: In the movie each of the siblings share something they remember about their mom. Kasey is most invested in her physical/monetary inheritance. Her greed leads to a family adventure. The clues and challenges reveal something about their mom and about each of her children.

- What did you notice about each of the siblings?
- How did their relationships remind you of your own family?
- What do you think Mom would have thought of their antics?
